

# reate an Priginal Coat of Arms

Directions: Create your own Coat of Arms based on YOUR hobbies, interests, personality, and character.

Your last name needs to be on your Coat of Arms. You will also choose at least one of each of the following: SYMBOL, ANIMAL, COLOR. and MOTTO from the list below that represents you OR you can make up your own, along with a reason that they represent you. Example: sun - symbolizes my bright personality. Example: music note - I love music and play the plano.

Example: baseball/football/baton/jersey - I love the sport.

You may even COMBINE symbols. Example: bear with a dove on its shoulder Example: sun with animal's face in the middle You will write a paragraph on the back to explain each of your choices.

NO pen or pencil will be accepted. You must color the entire Coat of Arms - no white may show. You may print out picture and glue them on (and color the backgrounds). You may design yours online, but will have fewer options.
